2016 Car Raffle Rules:

1. Eligibility

Scotia-Glenville Lions – Ford Car Raffle (the Contest) is open to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia who are at least eighteen (18) years old at the time of entry. Members of the Scotia-Glenville Lions and their family may purchase raffle tickets. The Contest is subject to federal, state, and local laws and regulations. The Contest is void where prohibited by law.

2. Sponsor

The Scotia-Glenville Lions 2016 Car Raffle is a fundraising activity in support of the Scotia-Glenville Lions (The Sponsor). All proceeds of the raffle will be used for the Lions Splash Pad Project in Collins Park. In the event the Splash Pad is not constructed, the raffle proceeds will be used for other community projects in the Scotia-Glenville area.

3. Agreement to Official Rules

Participation in the Raffle constitutes entrants full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor, which are final and binding. Winning a prize is contingent upon being compliant with these Official Rules and fulfilling all other requirements set forth herein.

4. Contest Period

The Contest begins on June 17, 2016, 9am EST and ends on December 9, 4pm EST (the Contest Period). Submissions will be accepted for the duration of the Contest using any of the following methods: Mail-In, On-line, person-to-person or through various business locations.

5. How to Enter

Participants may enter raffle by purchasing raffle tickets ('Tickets'). Tickets cost twenty (\$20) US dollars each or three for fifty (\$50) US dollars. Ticket price does not qualify as a donation to the Scotia-Glenville Lions Club. A maximum of 3000 tickets will be sold. Any entry form and payment after 3000 tickets are sold will be returned. No other refunds will be made, except by the sole discretion of the Sponsor. Tickets are non-transferable. Prizes will be issued only to the person listed on the winning ticket. All ticket sale information becomes the property of Sponsor.

Via Mail: This method of entry will be available for the entire Contest Period. Along with a check or money order for ticket purchase price, made payable to Scotia-Glenville Lions, submit the following: On a 3x5 card, handprint your full name, complete address, phone number (including area code) date of birth and email address and mail in an envelope with proper postage affixed to: Scotia-Glenville Lions, P.O. Box 2001, Scotia, New York, 12302. The Sponsor will complete the raffle ticket for the purchaser by filling in the name, address, email and phone number of the purchaser. The Sponsor will then place each completed raffle ticket stub in the secured raffle barrel. If purchaser sends a stamped and self-addressed envelope along with entry the ticket stubs will be returned; otherwise purchaser will receive an email from the Sponsor, confirming the ticket purchase and providing the ticket number(s). All mail-in entries must be postmarked by December 6, 2016 and received by December 8, 2016. Entries received after that these dates will be returned.

On-line: This method of entry will be available for the entire Contest Period. The Scotia-Glenville Lions website can be used to purchase raffle tickets. When a raffle ticket order is placed and funds have cleared, The Sponsor will complete the raffle ticket for the purchaser by filling in the name, address, email and phone number of the purchaser. The Sponsor will then place each completed raffle ticket stub in the secured raffle barrel. Online purchaser will receive an email from the Sponsor, confirming the ticket purchase and providing the ticket number(s). Ticket stubs will not be mailed back to purchaser.

Person-to-Person: This method of entry is available for the entire Contest Period. Tickets may be purchased by Scotia-Glenville Lions Club members. Purchaser is to complete the ticket stub information; it is the responsibility of the ticket purchaser to verify the contact information on the ticket stub is correct. Tickets must be sold by December 9, 2016, 4pm EST.

Business Locations: This method of entry is available for the entire Contest Period. Tickets may be purchased at businesses approved by the Scotia-Glenville Lions Club. A complete updated list of approved businesses will be located on the Scotia-Glenville Lions website (SGLions.org). Purchaser is to complete the ticket stub information; it is the responsibility of the ticket purchaser to verify the contact information on the ticket stub is correct. Tickets must be sold by December 8, 2016, 4pm EST.

6. Prize Drawing

Drawing will be held on December 9, 2016 around 4pm. The drawing location is set to be at the Morris Ford (872 NY-50, Ballston Lake), any changes to date or time will be announced on the Scotia-Glenville Lions website (SGLions.org) at least seven (7) days before the planned event. Any person with an eligible entry may view the drawing. A video of the drawing along with the potential winner's names will be posted on the Scotia-Glenville Lions website (SGLions.org) on or about December 10, 2016.

Each raffle entry constitutes an equal chance to win. The odds of being selected depend on the number of entries received. The maximum number of tickets that will be sold is 3000 and each ticket is numbered. Winners need not be present to win. The winning ticket will be drawn at random from a drum containing all eligible raffle tickets. The entrant Winning raffle tickets will not be returned to drum after each drawing.

The Sponsor will attempt to notify the potential winner via Certified US Mail, telephone or email on or about December 10, 2016. Winners will also be posted on the Scotia-Glenville Lions Website (SGLions.org) and Facebook pages. If the potential winner cannot be contacted within seven (7) days after the date of the first attempt to contact him/her, the Sponsor may select an alternate potential winner in his/her place at random from the remaining non-winning, eligible entries.

7. Winner Notification

The potential winners will be notified by email, mail or phone using contact information on ticket. In the event the ticket stub information is incorrect or ineligible, the Sponsor will advertise the winning ticket number on its website and Facebook page for a period of seven (7) calendar days.

Each potential First Prize winner will be required to complete, sign and submit a Declaration of Compliance within seven (7) calendar days from the date notice or attempted notice is sent, in order to claim his/her prize. Proof of age and proof of identity is required to claim prize. If a potential winner cannot be contacted, or fails to submit the Declaration of Compliance within the required time period (if applicable), or prize is returned as undeliverable, potential winner forfeits prize. If the potential winner is at least 18 but still considered a minor in his/her jurisdiction of residence, Sponsor reserves the right to award the prize in the name of his/her parent or legal guardian, who will be required to sign the Declaration of Compliance on the potential winners behalf and fulfill any other requirements imposed on winner set forth herein. Potential winners must continue to comply with all terms and conditions of these Official Rules, and winning is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements. In the event that a potential winner is disqualified for any reason, Sponsor will award the applicable prize to an alternate winner by random drawing from among all remaining eligible entries. Only three (3) alternate drawings will be held, after which the prize will remain un-awarded. Prizes will be fulfilled approximately 8-10 weeks after the conclusion of the Raffle.

8. Prizes

1st Prize (1) – \$23,600 credit towards MSRP of new car at Morris Ford –OR- \$15,000 cash

6th Prize (1) - \$500

1st Prize:

- Selected winner ('Winner') will receive a \$23,600 credit at Morris Ford (872 NY-50, Ballston Lake, NY 12019) towards the Manufacturers Suggested Retail Price (MSRP) of a new Ford Vehicle ('Grand Prize').
 - 2016 Ford Fusion MSRP starts at \$22,120
 - 2016 Ford Escape MSRP starts at \$23,600.
- In lieu of the Grand Prize, the selected winner may choose a cash option of \$15,000 ('Cash Grand Prize').
- Selection of the Grand Prize or Cash Grand Prize must be made in writing by the selected winner within 20 days of notification. If no prize is affirmatively elected, within this time period, the winner is deemed to have elected to receive the Cash Grand Prize.
- Winner assumes and must pay all taxes (State and Federal), fees and charges (including but not limited to taxes, license fees and any value of selected car including options over the credit provided).
- Before winner receives credit, IRS forms W-2G & 941 will be filed with the Internal Revenue Service to report the value of the prize won. The winner will also receive a copy of these forms.

2nd through 6th Prize:

- \$500 payable by check to name on ticket stub.

If fewer than 1700 raffle tickets are sold, the Sponsor reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to substitute 50% of the gross sales revenue from the tickets sold as of the time of the entry deadline in lieu of the 'Grand Prize'. Additionally, the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th prizes will be \$250.

9. General Conditions

In the event that the operation, security, or administration of the Contest is impaired in any way for any reason, including, but not limited to fraud, virus, bug, worm, unauthorized human intervention or other technical problem, or in the event the Contest is unable to run as planned for any other reason, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion, the Sponsor may, in its sole discretion, either (a) suspend the Contest to address the impairment and then resume the Raffle in a manner that best conforms to the spirit of these Official Rules or (b) terminate the Raffle and, in the event of termination, award the prize at random from among the eligible, non-suspect entries received up to the time of the impairment. The Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules. Failure by the Sponsor to enforce any provision of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.

10. Release and Limitations of Liability

By participating in the Contest, entrants agree to release and hold harmless the Sponsor, and each of their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, advertising and promotion agencies, other companies associated with the Raffle, and each of their respective officers, directors, employees, shareholders, representatives, and agents (the Released Parties) from and against any claim or cause of action arising out of participation in the Contest or receipt or use of the prize (including any travel or activity related thereto), including, but not limited to: (a) any technical errors associated with the Contest, including lost, interrupted or unavailable Internet Service Provider (ISP), network, server, wireless service provider, or other connections, availability or accessibility or miscommunications or failed computer, satellite, telephone, cellular tower or cable transmissions, lines, or technical failure or jumbled, scrambled, delayed, or misdirected transmissions or computer hardware or software malfunctions, failures or difficulties; (b) unauthorized human intervention in the Contest; (c) mechanical, network, electronic, computer, human, printing or typographical errors; (d) lost, late, incomplete, garbled, illegible, undelivered, stolen, damaged, delayed, postage-due or misdirected mail, entries, application downloads, (e) any other errors or problems in connection with the Contest, including, without limitation, errors that may occur in the administration of the Contest, the announcement of the winner, the cancellation or postponement of the event and/or the flyover, if applicable, the incorrect downloading of the application the processing of entries application downloads or in any Contest-related materials; or (f) injury, death, losses or damages of any kind, to persons or property which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from entrants participation in the Contest or acceptance, receipt or misuse of the prize (including any travel or activity related thereto). Entrant further agrees that in any cause of action, the Released Parties liability will be limited to the cost of entering and participating in the Contest, and in no event shall the entrant be entitled to receive attorney's fees. Released Parties are also not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by site users, tampering, hacking, or by any equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest. Entrant waives the right to claim any damages whatsoever, including, but not limited to, punitive, consequential, direct, or indirect damages.

11. Disputes

Except where prohibited, each entrant agrees that any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of, or connected with, the Raffle or any prize awarded shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the appropriate court located in New York. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, entrants rights and obligations, or the rights and obligations of the Sponsor in connection with the Sweepstakes, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of New York, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules, which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than New York.

12. Privacy

Winners grant permission for the use of their names, photographs/likenesses for advertising and promotion for this and similar promotions without compensation, unless prohibited by law. Information collected from non-winning tickets will remain private with the Sponsor and will not be sold.

13. Winner List

To request the name of the winner send a self-addressed stamped envelope to Scotia-Glenville Lions, P.O. Box, Scotia, New York, 12302. Winner List requests will only be accepted after the promotion end date (listed above) until March 1, 2017. The Winner's List may also be viewed the Scotia-Glenville Lions website (SGLions.org) through April 1, 2017.
